Coaching is an interaction style used to build the capacity of parents and other caregivers to promote child learning and development within and across typical routines and caregiving contexts. This two-day workshop will include the background and rationale for the use of caregiver coaching and provide participants with an in-depth understanding of how to operationalize the five research-based characteristics that lead to the intended outcomes: (1) joint planning, (2) observation, (3) action/practice, (4) reflection, and (5) feedback. Participants will analyze videos of caregiver coaching and have the opportunity to build their coaching skills through practice using commonly occurring scenarios.

Our presenters:

Dathan Rush, Director of the Family, Infant and Preschool Program (FIPP), Western Carolina Center in Morganton, North Carolina, has published articles and provided training in the areas of coaching, supporting children and families in natural learning environments, and teaming in early intervention. Dr. Rush coauthored the texts *Coaching Families and Colleagues in Early Childhood Intervention*, *The Early Childhood Coaching Handbook*, and *The Early Intervention Teaming Handbook: The Primary Service Provider Approach*.

M'Lisa Shelden, Chair and Program Director, Wichita State University, has 30+ years of experience in developmental disabilities and early intervention. Prior to joining the Family, Infant and Preschool Program (FIPP) in 2002, Dr. Shelden served as Associate Professor in the Department of Physical Therapy at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center. M'Lisa is a graduate Fellow of ZERO TO THREE. She has coauthored several texts - *Physical Therapy under IDEA*, *Coaching Families and Colleagues in Early Childhood Intervention*, *The Early Childhood Coaching Handbook*, and *The Early Intervention Teaming Handbook: The Primary Service Provider Approach*.
